WHAT IS THE OPAL PROGRAM?

The Oregon Psychiatric Access Line is a state funded program that offers psychiatric telephone consultation to all prescribing clinicians in the state. The program is insurance blind and covers patients of all ages. State funding allows this program to be provided with no cost to the provider or to patients. The ongoing vision of this program is to expand the availability of high-quality mental health treatment to all Oregonians through the support of their medical home via:

- timely psychiatric phone consultation to medical providers
- practitioner education
- primary care treatment algorithms
- promotion of linkages with private and public community mental health professionals
